<b>Connection</b>	Some species of sharks must swim continually to keep water flowing through their gills, or else they will die. We will learn that we cannot always be rushing around; to stay spiritually alive, we need to stop and spend time listening to Jesus.	To keep away from danger, certain species of fish swim in schools; there is safety in numbers. We will learn that, when God is on our side, one is the only number we need to be safe.	When female sea turtles lay their eggs on the beach, they protect them by covering the little ones with sand and grass. We will learn that God takes care of us and protects us.	With their hard exoskeleton and their sharp claws, crabs have a reputation for being a bit, well “crabby.” We will learn that even on our crabbiest day, God can come along and turn it around.
